
♥ BASIC HORIZONTAL ASSEMBLY




The first row is completed. Be sure to glue. Interlock second row pieces by inserting. the points that connect the pockets.

O CIRCULAR ASSEMBLY

When you join the pieces in a circle, they make a base for most three-dimensional objects that extend upward. Once you have learned the trick of the triangular piece, e.g. how each side of the triangle works, you can construct any shape you fancy. Start with small projects such as these doll-shaped containers.
